## Accepting:

- Any items from the Halton Healthcare Child Life Wish List that are brand new, unopened, still have the tag, and come from a smoke-free home
- New pajamas, with the tags attached (size: premature – teen)

### **Not Accepting:**

- Stuffed animals or knit items
- Used toys
- Used clothing
- Used magazines or books
- Furniture, large electronics or artwork
- Candy or food products
- Latex products (including balloons)
- Toys with projectiles or imitation weapons, ie. Nerf
- Large baby items, ie. swings, bouncy chairs, strollers, high chairs
- Personal notes or cards for patients
- Sanitizer or cleaning products
